## PHASES OF EDUCATION

| <b>Private Nurseries</b>                   | – Typically for 2-4 year olds (some care for younger children) |
| <b>Primary Schools</b>                     | – Typically teaching pupils from 4-11                          |
| <b>Secondary Schools</b>                   | – Typically teaching pupils from 11 to 16 – or from 11 to 18   |
| <b>Sixth Form Centres Centres/Colleges</b> | – Typically teaching pupils from 16 to 18/19                   |

## BUDGETS AND CONTROL

| <b>State Schools</b>       | – Government funded - control 90%+ of budgets (balance through local authority) |
| <b>Academy/Free</b>        | – Government funded - full budgetary control                                    |
| <b>Independent/Private</b> | – Self-funded and controlled  |
| <b>Special Schools</b>     | – Both government and independent funding and control                           |
